Where milestones met momentum, and a new chapter began.

NIC Hyderabad marked a defining milestone this quarter, three years of impact, with a celebration that captured the spirit of Pakistan's growing startup movement.

Federal IT & Telecommunication Minister Shaza Fatima Khawaja joined founders, investors and partners to celebrate the graduation of 32 startups from Cohorts 4 and 5, and to recognise how Hyderabad's entrepreneurs are helping shape Pakistan's digital future.

While we looked back on three years of progress, we also opened a new chapter with the induction of Cohort 7, a fresh wave of founders ready to build what's next. And at our 6th Investor Summit, national and global investors met the startups that will carry this momentum forward.

Add to that a season of national awards and international recognition, and it's clear: innovation from Hyderabad isn't just thriving, it's setting the pace for what comes next.









Cohort 7: The Journey Begins

Over four dynamic days, NIC Hyderabad heard more than 100 pitches from founders driven by solid research, fearless ambition, and months of preparation. Each presentation showcased bold, problem-solving ideas that reflected the spirit of innovation across Sindh. The panels, featuring industry experts, seasoned entrepreneurs, and ecosystem leaders, turned evaluation into mentorship, offering sharp insights and constructive feedback that helped founders refine their models and sharpen their storytelling. The final day was dedicated to startups outside Hyderabad, who pitched virtually, ensuring every promising idea, no matter where it came from, had a fair chance to shine.

From over 300 bold ideas, 25 startups made the cut. Over the next four months, they'll pitch, pivot, and push boundaries with the support of mentors, industry experts, and an active investor network.
